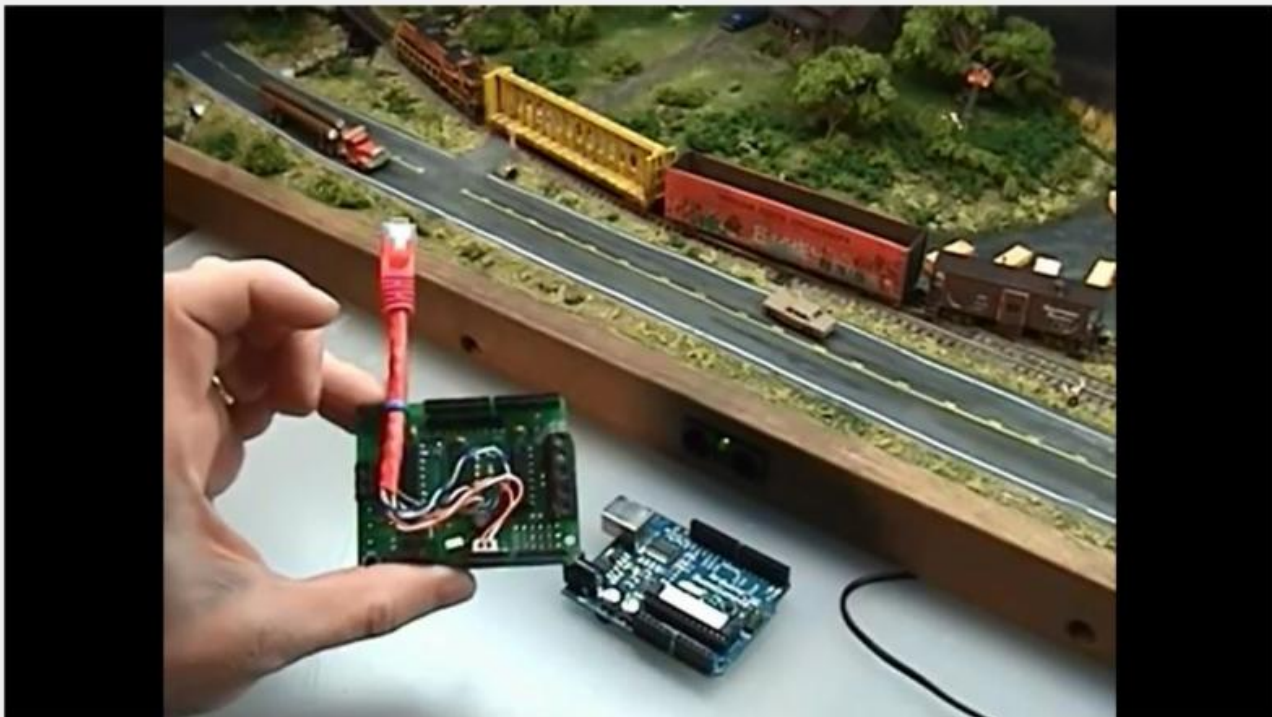

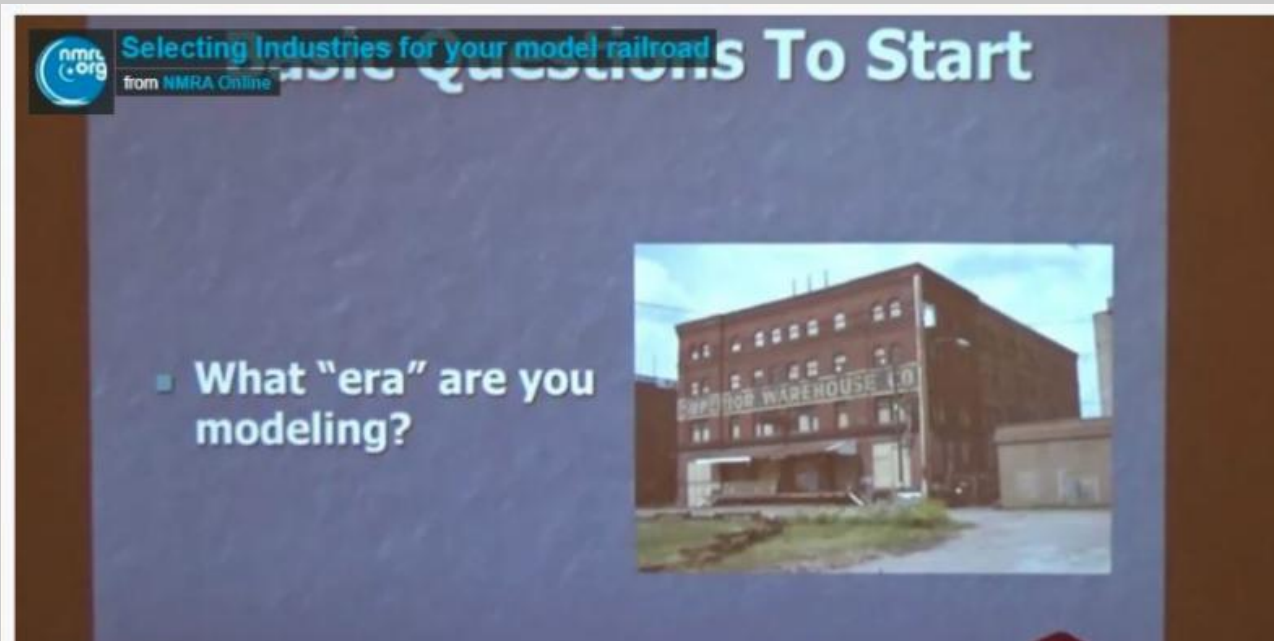

Horsted Keynes Signal Box

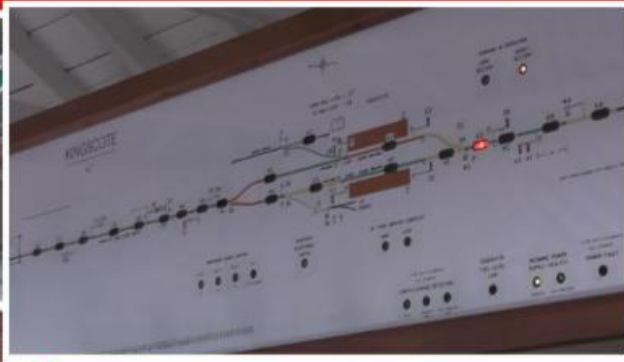


Horsted Keynes Signal Box
