



Service Returns to the Clinchfield Railroad














Service Returns to the Clinchfield Railroad



CPKC Lloydminster Sub & Red Barns at Wilkie

On September 15, 2025, *Lakeshore Rail Videos* set out on a weeklong trip across Saskatchewan. Their first stop was to shoot the CPKC Lloydminster Sub, which hosts a train every other day between Wilkie and Lloydminster. Today's train, CPKC D65-15 had CP 5034, CP 6258 and CP 3061 with 72 cars for Lloyd. Their first stop is the wooden elevator at Baldwinton, and then another elevator at Marsden. After Marsden, the railway swings north and climbs through the Battle River Valley towards Lloydminster. Later that evening, back in Wilkie they caught CPKC D74-16 building their train with CP 7308, CP 2245, CP 9010 and CP 9023 before departing town with a ballast train for Hardisty.

These units were purchased from Lombard Hobbies on preorder. He is definitely glad he did as they seem to be selling out quick across all stores online, so grab one or more if you can!


